PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS





SHAPE

The MFAT and ADRA New Zealandfunded Sustainable Health, Agriculture, Protection, and Empowerment (SHAPE) project completed the following activities:

- Conducted a Farmer Field Day meeting and discussing the research results with 66 farmers from the project's target villages.

- Watershed conservation meeting across 12 villages in the project's target area has successful finished. They discussed using offline maps to identify the critical watershed conservation areas, allowing for precise identification."

ReCAP

Relief for Vulnerable Populations (ReCAP) project completed the following activities:

- For the Multipurpose Cash Assistant (MPCA), the project team is beginning to select beneficiaries for cash distribution in the Magway Region. Initially, 6 villages were selected from this area, totaling 599 households.

- Visited Mobile Medical Unit 3 in Mon State for regular field monitoring. They observed how the MMU operates, interviewed patients and village leaders to check the health services.
